ONLINE TRAINING COURSE

Course Objectives

Exaquantum/SER assists users in determining the cause of incidents and trips by automatically collecting and storing all alarm and event messages and data points of interest from plant equipment, such as control and safety systems. The course provides an overview of the product as well as allowing students to configure a system that starts to collect alarm and event data and the creation of trip reports.



Prerequisite Knowledge

This course assumes that the user is familiar with Microsoft Windows and the basic Microsoft Windows terminology. It also assumes that attendees are familiar with Exaquantum Administration to the level which would be obtained by attending the Exaquantum Administrations Course (NTPP901). Knowledge of SQL Server Management Studio is essential.



Who Should Attend

This course is designed for those users who wish to get more familiar with the Exaquantum Sequence of Events Recorder product.
