



How can I display a popup trend for a mimic item in my Exaquantum Explorer documents?

Exaquantum Explorer has a control called the Tag Detail Panel (usually referred to as just the Tag Panel) which is designed for such a task.

You need to do the following things:

- 1) Right click on the Palette and choose Add ActiveX Control, scroll through the list and select the "Yokogawa Exaquantum Tag Panel".
- 2) Drag the control onto the Explorer Document you wish to use it with.
- 3) Select the control you wish to use as the trigger for the popup – usually this is a simple text box or button.
- 4) Right click the control and select Object Properties.
- 5) On the Events tab click into the "EventClick" field to add some code.
- 6) Enter the following text `QTagPanelCtl1.X.ShowTagPanel <Tag Name>` where `<Tag Name>` is the full path of the tag you wish to be used in the popup trend. E.g. "Root.Folder1.FB1.PV".
- 7) If you are using a textbox that is displaying the value of a tag (as is typical in mimics) you can drag the `.Name` item from the Data Selector into the Tag field in the Object Properties and then refer to it in the script e.g. `QTagPanelCtl1.X.ShowTagPanel this.Tag`.
