Chapter 2 ARA Reporting Philosophy


A typical plant environment has different departments in ARA these departments are split into four main reporting areas:

Performance


Operations

2.1 Management Reports

Management reports are high level reports which have a collection of data and operational information from various departments that is presented in an understandable way, allowing managers to make better-informed decisions.




2.2 Performance Reports

Performance reports are high level reports that define and measure the systems overall success. It provides an overview of how the system is performing. The reports are designed to help the system users make the required decisions.




2.3 Operation Reports

Operation reports are intended to report about operational details that reflects current activity of the plant. Operational reporting is intended to support the day-to-day activities of the plant.



2.4 Maintenance Reports

Maintenance reports are intended for the Maintenance department, which includes engineers the reports help identify issues occurring in the plant and will highlight areas that may require maintenance.
